# **President's Spin**

Allow me to introduce myself as the new club president; for those who do not know me, I have been a member of BCBC since the late 1990's. I have previously served as ride coordinator, and until recently elected as president, I served as treasurer. I ran for president because I was concerned about the decline in club membership and a drop off in rider participation.

I have developed a list of goals that I hope to implement during my tenure as president including:

- Procure a new software solution to better manage the club, which will allow us to communicate ride and event information in a more efficient manner than our current methods. We have already initiated a process to evaluate what other bike clubs are take some time to transition, and train club members, on the use of a new program, so we wanted to get started now.
- Revise our current ride classification to include a pace designation, so that club members will know what the average speed of a ride is going to be. This may also involve adding more rides, and locations. This is in no way intended to limit those individuals who want to ride faster; however, it is intended to help new riders feel welcome to our club and assimilate into road riding safely. I want to offer options for all rider levels.
- Start an Introduction to Road Cycling Riding, to recruit new club members. These rides would cover the basics of

- riding such as bike fit, maintenance and rules of the road, followed by a short ride, with rides getting progressively longer as the program progresses. Since it is already September, we will not introduce this until the Spring of 2026. In the meantime, we will be looking for volunteers to help develop a curriculum and lead these rides.
- Schedule more social events and fun rides. Some suggested ideas are; happy hour get togethers, ice cream social rides, and/or a club night at the Lehigh Velodrome. If club members have any other suggestions, or would like to host an event, please feel free to let me know.

I am looking forward to the next sevusing and hope to decide soon. It will eral years as your president and I'm excited about the changes we are trying to bring to the club. As with any non-profit organization, its success is based on the participation of its members. We can always use volunteers, either as a committee member, or as a one-time helper at a specific event (The ShooFly ride can always use help). We currently are looking to fill executive board positions for Secretary and Membership Coordinator. If you are interested, please contact me for details on what those positions involve.

# BERKS COUNTY BICYCLE CLUB RIDES

First Number: Terrain Rating Terrain rating 1-5 rates the total hilliness of the ride.

1 = FLAT-easiest

2= GENTLY ROLLING HILLS-moderate terrain with easiest of hills (Almost anyone can handle).

3= SOME HILLS-Moderate hills with some steeper grades (Moderately Challenging-but within the ability of most rid-

**4= HILLY–**The number and difficulty of hills is quite substantial (Very Challenging).

5= EXTREMELY HILLY-Extreme Challenge- steep and long hills most of the ride. Requires a very high fitness level).

Second Number: Total Mileage for ride Please note the Club policy on protective

headgear: ALL Riders must wear Snell/ANSI rated helmets. Ride Host/ Hostess will NOT give cue sheets to riders without helmets and that rider will not be considered an official participant of the Club ride.

Please have your bike in proper working order BEFORE the start of ride. Arrive 10-15 minutes before start time so that all rides leave on time. Bring a spare tube or patch kit, and at least one water bottle.

If weather conditions are questionable, the ride host may notify club members by posting a message on Facebook prior to the ride or make a decision at the starting location based on road conditions and the forecast.


